Resurfacing Project Begins on Higgins Road, Mannheim Road/Interstate 190 Interchange

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a resurfacing project is underway on Higgins Road (Illinois 72) between Touhy Avenue and Cumberland Avenue (Illinois 171), as well as the ramps at the Mannheim Road (U.S. 45) and the Kennedy Expressway (Interstate 190) interchange.

In order to complete the work, nightly lane and ramp closures will take place on Higgins Road, and at the Mannheim Road/Interstate 190 interchange.

Extending through Des Plaines, Park Ridge and Rosemont, the resurfacing project will improve safety and mobility along Higgins Road and at the Mannheim Road/Kennedy Expressway interchange. As part of the project, new sidewalk ramps along Higgins Road will provide improved accessibility in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
