Full Closure of U.S. 14 at the CN Railroad Tracks for Crossing Repairs

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a full closure will take place on Northwest Highway (U.S. 14) at the Canadian National Railroad tracks, in Barrington, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, June 4. The closure is necessary to repair the at-grade crossing.

Beginning at 9 a.m. June 4, Northwest Highway will be fully closed at the railroad tracks for emergency repairs. A posted detour will direct northbound U.S. 14 traffic to go west on Lake Cook Road and north on Illinois 59 to meet back with Northwest Highway. Southbound U.S. 14 traffic should take the reverse route.

The full closure will be in place until 6 p.m. Friday, June 8, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
