Lane closures set July 2 for I-74 in Knox County

GALESBURG — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that intermittent lane closures on the bridge that carries westbound Interstate 74 over Pope Creek in Knox County will begin Monday, July 2.

The closures are necessary for crews to set bridge beams and will begin at 10 p.m. July 2. Work is expected to be complete by 6 a.m. July 3, weather permitting. Informational message boards and Illinois State Police will be present prior to the closures.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
