Temporary Lane Closures Sunday on the Kennedy Expressway for Bridge Inspections

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that temporary lane closures will take place on the Kennedy Expressway (Interstate 90), from Central Avenue to the Edens Expressway (Interstate 94) junction, in Chicago, beginning, weather permitting, Sunday, March 11th. The closures are necessary to perform routine bridge inspections over the Kennedy on Montrose Avenue, Central Avenue, Cicero Avenue and several adjacent railroad bridges.

Starting at 6:30 a.m. Sunday, various lanes on the Kennedy Expressway will be closed until noon. The closures will alternate directions, in a moving operation, keeping a minimum of one lane open at all times.

All lanes are expected to be open by noon Sunday.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
