## **Overnight Lane Closures Begin on the Kennedy Expressway at Addison Street**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that overnight lane closures will take place on the Kennedy Expressway (Interstate 90) under Addison Street, in Chicago, beginning, weather permitting, the week of March 19. The lane closures are necessary for a bridge repair project on the structure that carries Addison Street over the Kennedy.

In order to complete the bridge repairs, temporary, overnight lane closures will take place in both directions on the Kennedy Expressway at Addison Street. A permanent shoulder closure also will take place in the express lanes on the Kennedy. Travel lanes will be reduced during construction.

The project will extend the life of the structure that carries Addison Street over the Kennedy Expressway. The overall project is expected to be completed in May 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
