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Overnight Lane and Ramp Closures Begin on the Inbound Kennedy for Bridge Repair Project

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a bridge repair project will require nightly lane closures on the inbound Kennedy Expressway (southbound Interstate 90/94) between North Street and Ohio Street, in Chicago, beginning, weather permitting, Thursday, March 22.

In order to complete the work, lane closures will take place on the inbound Kennedy from North Street to Ohio Street, reducing the expressway to a single lane, when necessary. The Kennedy Reversible Lanes will be impacted by the nightly closures, as well as ramps from the southbound Kennedy to Augusta Boulevard, Ogden Avenue and Ohio Street.

Lane and ramp closures will take place anytime between the following times:

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday
- 10 p.m. Friday to 8 a.m. Saturday
- 9 p.m. Saturday to 8 a.m. Sunday

The bridge repair project is expected to be completed by May 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
