Cumberland Circle Reconstruction Begins in Des Plaines

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a reconstruction project will take place at the intersection of Golf Road (Illinois 58) and Wolf Road, known as the Cumberland Circle, in Des Plaines, beginning, weather permitting, Tuesday, April 3. The project will reconstruct the existing traffic circle into a modern roundabout.

In order to complete the work, traffic at the Cumberland Circle will be reduced to one lane.

The overall project will enhance safety and mobility at the intersection by providing clearly-defined lane assignments and improved entry angles. The roundabout will feature a truck apron for buses and trucks, splitter islands to deflect vehicles into their proper lanes, and designated pedestrian and bicyclist crossings. The project also includes lighting and drainage work, as well new overhead signage.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
