## **I-74 Roadwork Begins April 2 near Ogden** *Lane closures to begin on or about April 16*

**OGDEN** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces work will begin April 2 on the driving lane of eastbound Interstate 74 from one mile west of the Ogden interchange to two miles east, with lane closures beginning on or about April 16, weather permitting. One lane in each direction on I-74 will remain open at all times during this work.

Work is expected to last through the end of April.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
