Pavement Reflectors on I-70 near Troy in Madison County

Troy - The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced I-70 will be intermittently restricted to one lane from the Interstate 55/70/270 interchange to 2.5 miles east of the Interstate 55/70/270 interchange starting Monday, April 2, 2018, weather permitting. The restrictions will take place in the eastbound direction between 6:00 AM to 3:00 PM and in the westbound direction between 9:00 AM and 6:00 PM. These restrictions are necessary to install pavement reflectors. All work is expected to be completed by mid-April 2018.

Motorists are urged to use caution, obey all warning signs and allow extra time when traveling through the work zone.
