Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on I-88 from IL 78 near Lyndon to Sand Road will resume work on Monday, March 12, 2018. Civil Constructors is starting the second phase of a \$12.4 million project to improve the nine mile section of I-88.

Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction as the contractor will begin by making concrete repairs to the pavement. The project also includes milling off the existing bituminous overlay and resurfacing the roadway.

The pavement repairs, resurfacing of the roadway, and work on the bridges are scheduled to be completed by mid-November.

Drivers should be alert for the lane closures and for slow moving construction vehicles entering and exiting the work areas.

Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
