Resurfacing, Pedestrian Improvements on Irving Park Road from Judd Avenue to Des Plaines River Road

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures will take place on Irving Park Road (Illinois 19) between Judd Avenue and Des Plaines River Road, in Schiller Park, beginning this week, weather permitting.

In order to complete the work, daily lane closures will take place on Irving Park Road between Judd Avenue and Des Plaines River Road while construction activities are taking place.

The lane closures are part of an overall project along Irving Park Road between Seymour Avenue and Des Plaines River Road. The scope of the project consists of resurfacing, ADA-compliant pedestrian ramps and improved drainage.

The overall project is expected to be completed in Summer 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
