## **Resurfacing, Sidewalk Improvements along Cicero Avenue from Congress Parkway to CC&P Railroad**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures will take place on Cicero Avenue (Illinois 50) between Congress Parkway and the CC&P Railroad, located south of 31<sup>st</sup> Street, in Chicago and Cicero, beginning this week, weather permitting. The lane closures are necessary for a resurfacing project along Cicero Avenue.

In order to complete the work, daytime lane closures will take place on Cicero Avenue between Congress Parkway and the CC&P Railroad, located south of 31<sup>st</sup> Street.

The scope of the project consists of resurfacing and pavement patching, as well as sidewalk improvements compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The overall project is expected to be completed in Summer 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
