Streetscape Improvements on Northwest Highway in Park Ridge

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that intermittent lane closures will take place on Northwest Highway between Touhy Avenue and Washington Street, in Park Ridge, for a streetscape project, beginning, weather permitting, Tuesday, May 29.

In order to complete the work, intermittent lane closures and parking lane closures will take place along Northwest Highway from Touhy Avenue to Washington Street. The lane closures are necessary for crews to replace sidewalk and curb, and traffic impacts will occur in stages. Businesses will have temporary access to storefronts while sidewalk construction is taking place.

The scope of the project includes landscaping, lighting and sidewalk improvements, including additional benches and bicycle racks. The project also consists of roadway resurfacing after the sidewalk construction is completed.

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
