## **Interchange Closure at I-70 & IL 127 Greenville, Illinois**

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced there will be periodic daytime closures of the I-70 interchange ramps at IL 127, Exit 45, in Greenville beginning Wednesday, May 16, 2018, weather permitting. These closures are necessary to complete drainage improvements and paving of the interchange ramps.

During the closures, a marked detour will be in place directing I-70 westbound motorists to Greenville via exit 52 at Mulberry Grove and I-70 eastbound motorists to Greenville via exit 41. The ramps in one direction will be opened before the ramps in the other direction are closed (i.e., eastbound ramps will be opened before the westbound ramps are closed). These interchange improvements are expected to be completed by June 1, 2018. If you drive through the work zone, please stay alert and use extra caution.
