Lane closures begin June 22 for U.S. 34 in Knox Co.

GALESBURG – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that overnight lane closures and intermittent daily lane reductions will begin Monday, June 11, for U.S. 34 between Seminary Street and Knox County Highway 9.

The closures are necessary for crews to perform pavement patching. Work is expected to be complete by Friday, June 22, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
