Illinois 89 south of McNabb to close Sept. 25

Rail crossing replacement expected to take several days

McNABB – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that Illinois 89 south of McNabb will close Tuesday, Sept. 25.

The closure is necessary so that the Norfolk Southern Railroad can replace its crossing surface. Motorists must use alternate routes during the project, which is expected to be complete by the morning of Sept. 29.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
