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Bond County

Illinois 127 from Montgomery County line to IL 140

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. These closures will be necessary to make pavement repairs. This project is expected to be completed by late summer of this year. A press release detailing these closures will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Clinton County

Illinois 161 over Crooked Creek near Centralia

All traffic lanes will remain closed on this project. This closure is necessary to raise the grade and build a new bridge over Crooked Creek. The work is expected to be completed by the end of this year. Detours are in place to direct traffic around the closure.

Interstate 64 from the St. Clair County line to the Washington County line

Traffic lanes will be reduced from two lanes to one in each direction. These lane closures are necessary to make pavement repairs. The work is expected to be completed by mid-summer of this year. A press release detailing this work will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Illinois 160 / Illinois 177 from Sand Hill Road to the Washington County line

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. These closures will be necessary to make pavement repairs. This project is expected to be completed by mid-summer of this year. A press release detailing these closures will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Illinois 160 from Illinois 161 in New Baden to 4th Street in Trenton

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. These closures will be necessary to make pavement repairs. This project is expected to be completed by the fall of this year.

Illinois 160 from Illinois 161 to Illinois 177

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. These closures will be necessary to make pavement repairs. This project is expected to be completed by mid-summer of this year. A press release detailing these closures will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Greene County

Illinois 267 over Lick Creek

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing temporary traffic signals. This closure will be necessary to make bridge repairs. This project is expected to be completed by fall of this year. A press release detailing these closures will be issued once this work is scheduled.

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Greene / Jersey Counties

Illinois 16 / Illinois 100 from Busby Lane to the Joe Paige Bridge

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. These closures will be necessary to make pavement and shoulder repairs. This project is expected to be completed by late summer of this year. A press release detailing these closures will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Madison County

US 67 - Clark Bridge over the Mississippi River

Traffic lanes will be reduced from two lanes to one lane in each direction. These lane closures are necessary to make bridge repairs. This project is expected to be completed by late summer of this year. A press release detailing this work will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Illinois 255 from Seminary Road to Illinois 111 / Illinois 267

Traffic lanes will be reduced from two lanes to one lane in each direction. These lane closures are necessary to make pavement repairs. This project is expected to be completed by mid-summer of this year. A press release detailing this work will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Illinois 160 from the Clinton County line to Broadway in Highland

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. These closures will be necessary to make pavement repairs. This project is expected to be completed by the fall of this year. A press release detailing these closures will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Monroe County

Interstate 255 from the Mississippi River to Illinois 3 in Columbia

Traffic lanes will be reduced from three lanes to one lane in each direction through this work zone. These lane closures are necessary to make pavement repairs. This work will be performed at night and is expected to be completed by early summer of this year. A press release detailing this work will be issued once this work is scheduled.

St Clair County

Martin Luther King Bridge Ramps over Interstate 55/64, Missouri Avenue and the Railroad in E. St. Louis

All traffic lanes will remain closed on this project. This closure is necessary to remove the existing truss bridge and build a new bridge over the Railroad and to repair the bridges over Interstate 55/64 and Missouri Avenue. The work is expected to be completed in late 2019. Detours are in place to direct traffic around the closure.

Illinois 15 from Illinois 163 to Interstate 255

Traffic lanes will be reduced from three lanes to two lanes in each direction through this work zone. These lane closures are necessary to make pavement repairs and intersection improvements. This work is expected to be completed by the fall of this year.

Illinois 158 from Anglers Club Road to Atlanta Drive in Belleville

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. These closures will be necessary to make pavement repairs. This project is expected to be completed by mid-summer of this year. A press release detailing these closures will be issued once this work is scheduled.

Randolph County

Illinois 150 from Murphysboro Road to Briar Hill Road

Traffic lanes will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. These closures will be necessary to make pavement repairs.
