## **Illinois 31, Miller Road work in Carpentersville**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that improvements to the intersection of Illinois 31 (Western Avenue) and Miller Road in Carpentersville will begin today.

The project, which requires daytime lane closures with narrower lanes, consists of adding a new northbound left-turn lane from Illinois 31 onto Miller Road. Wider shoulders, a bike path and drainage improvements also will be built.

The work is expected to be complete by the end of November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
