Torrence Avenue patching and resurfacing

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that daily lane closures will be required on Torrence Avenue (Illinois 83) from south of Interstate 80, in Lansing, to Glenwood Dyer Road, in Lynwood, beginning, weather permitting, April 29.

The closures are necessary for pavement patching and resurfacing as well as the installation of new pedestrian crossings.

The work is expected to be complete by the end of November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
