## Daily Harlem Avenue lane closures in south suburbs

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that resurfacing of Harlem Avenue (Illinois 43) from 159<sup>th</sup> Street (U.S. 6) in Tinley Park to Lincoln Highway (U.S. 30) in Matteson and Frankfort Square will require daily lane closures with flaggers beginning, weather permitting, April 29

The work is expected to be complete between U.S. 30 and 171<sup>st</sup> Street by October. The work between 171<sup>st</sup> Street and 159<sup>th</sup> Street is expected to be completed next June.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to the flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
