## Lane closures on Northwest Highway in Arlington Heights, Mount Prospect and Des Plaines

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that resurfacing and patching of Northwest Highway (U.S. 14) from Vail Avenue, in Arlington Heights, to State Street, in Des Plaines, will require daytime lane closures and sidewalk closures beginning, weather permitting, this week.

In addition to the resurfacing, the project consists of the installation of new sidewalk pedestrian ramps. There will be no lane closures Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. for eastbound lanes and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. for westbound lanes.

The work is expected to be complete by June 2020.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
