Plainfield Road, Willow Springs Road intersection work

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that signal modernization and improvements to the intersection of Plainfield Road and Willow Springs Road, in Countryside, will require permanent lane closures beginning, weather permitting, May 1.

The project consists of new signals, sidewalk and driveway replacements, storm sewer installation and the addition of right turn lanes in each direction on Willow Springs Road.

In order to complete the project, traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction on Willow Springs Road with temporary traffic signals. Access to driveways and side streets will be maintained in the work zone.

The work is expected to be complete by the end of August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
