## **Lane closures begin April 3 on U.S. 150 in Champaign**

**CHAMPAIGN** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will begin on U.S. 150 (Bloomington Road) from Prospect Avenue to Mattis Avenue April 3. The project includes patching, milling and resurfacing, ADA sidewalk improvements, and signal and lighting modernization. Work is expected to conclude mid-July, weather permitting.

One traffic lane will remain open at all times, but motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
