Night work on Bradley Avenue bridge set April 15

CHAMPAIGN – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that nighttime work in [the Bradley Avenue bridge work zone](#) over Interstate 57 will begin Monday, April 15.

Crews will be placing a barrier wall on the shoulder of I-57 and installing a shield over the bridge beams, which will require one lane to be closed in each direction. The work will take place between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. and is expected to last four nights. Another phase of nighttime work will be needed later this month for bridge beam removal.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
