Bridge painting along I-74 begins April 15 *Spans over U.S. 150, CH 22 near Farmer City*

FARMER CITY – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that painting of two bridges on Interstate 74 near Farmer City will begin Monday, April 15.

The work is on the bridges that carry I-74 over U.S. 150 and DeWitt County Highway 22 and will require intermittent lane closures on the roads under the spans. Painting is expected to take about six weeks for each bridge.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
