Lane Restrictions on Interstate 70 Greenville, Illinois

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced there will be periodic lane closures in each direction on Interstate 70 from Sugar Loaf Road (mile post 38) to east of Pleasant Mound Avenue (mile post 48) near Greenville beginning Monday, April 29, 2019, weather permitting. These closures are necessary to complete the final cleanup work related to the bridge and pavement rehabilitation work already completed. This remaining work is expected to be completed by late May 2019. Traffic will be maintained utilizing message boards, flaggers, signs, and other traffic control devices.

The Department advises the travelling public to follow all construction signs and drive with caution through the work zones. Delays should be expected and the use of alternate routes may be beneficial.
