## Illinois 160/177 in Clinton County

**New Memphis** – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that Illinois 160/177 from west of Sand Hill Road to west of the Kaskaskia River will be intermittently restricted to one lane beginning Wednesday, May 1, 2019, weather permitting. This work will take place daily between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Traffic in each direction will be maintained using flaggers. This work is necessary to complete pavement repairs, shoulder widening, and asphalt resurfacing. This work is expected to be completed by the end of July 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

The contractor on this project is Christ Brothers Asphalt, Inc., of Lebanon, Illinois.
