Interstate 64 Lane Closures in Clinton County

Damiansville – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that Interstate 64 from east of Exit 27 to east of Exit 34 will have various lane restrictions in each direction beginning at 6PM on April 22, 2019, weather permitting. Lane closures can be expected between the hours of 6PM and 9AM on weekdays and all day on Saturdays and Sundays. One lane of traffic will remain open at all times. This work is necessary to complete pavement repairs. Work is anticipated to be completed in early July 2019.

The Department advises the travelling public to follow all construction signs and drive with caution through the work zones. Delays should be expected and the use of alternate routes may be beneficial.

The contractor on this project is Keeley & Sons, Inc., of East St. Louis, Illinois.
