Work on Illinois 110/336 in Adams County set April 29

MENDON — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on Illinois 110/336 from 10 miles south of the Hancock County line, near Mendon, to the county line will begin the week of April 29.

The project involves pavement sealing and resurfacing, striping, and drainage improvements on Illinois 110/336 as well as on Illinois 61. The work will require lane closures with one lane open in each direction at all times. Traffic at the Illinois 61 interchange will periodically be reduced to one lane controlled by flaggers. The project is expected to be complete by Aug. 16.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
