Work on Illinois 4 to begin May 1

Construction will be between Auburn and Virden

AUBURN —The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on Illinois 4 between Auburn and Virden will begin Wednesday, May 1.

The work zone will be from 0.3 miles south of Illinois 104 in Auburn to north of George Street in Virden, where crews will make improvements to intersections, shoulders, sidewalks, drainage and ditches as well as patching and resurfacing. The project will require lane closures and is expected to be complete by Nov. 26.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
