Illinois 100 to close April 22 at Lewistown *Road repairs to fix recurring dip*

LEWISTOWN – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on Illinois 100 just north of Lewistown will begin Monday, April 22.

The work involves repairing a box culvert that has caused recurring dips in the road. To facilitate the work, Illinois 100 will be closed between Lewistown and Illinois 78. The posted detour will use Illinois 78 and U.S. 24. Construction is expected to last about three weeks.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
