Patching on Illinois 41 begins April 15

AVON — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that pavement patching on Illinois 41 from Avon to Illinois 9 will begin Monday, April 15.

The patching will require daytime lane closures, and traffic will be controlled by flaggers. Work is expected to be complete by June 15.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
