Patching on 24th Street in Quincy begins April 24

QUINCY – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that pavement patching on 24th Street (Illinois 96) in Quincy will begin Wednesday, April 24.

Patching will take place between Broadway Avenue (Illinois 104) and Locust Street and will require lane closures, with two-way traffic maintained by flaggers. Work is expected to be complete by the end of May.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
