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Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on I-88 near Rock Falls will begin on April 22, 2019. Martin & Co. Excavating will be completing the \$210,982 project to mill and resurface the bridge roadway approaches on three structures: 0.25 mile west of IL 40, over Polo Road and at Exit 44, 0.6 miles west of US 30 near Rock Falls.

Lane closures over the structures will be utilized to direct traffic thru the work areas. Work is expected to be completed by May 31, 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
