Pavement repairs on U.S. 24 begin April 22 *Work zone between East Peoria and Washington*

EAST PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on U.S. 24 (Boyd Parkway) between East Peoria and Washington will begin Monday, April 22.

The work involves repairing joints between the lanes from College Drive in East Peoria to Cummings Lane in Washington and will require lane closures. Repairs are expected to be complete within two to three weeks, and permanent pavement markings will be applied about two weeks after completion.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
