Traffic stoppages set April 26 for U.S. 24/150 work zone *Due to construction at interchange with Illinois 116*

EAST PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that there will be intermittent stoppages of traffic in the westbound lanes of U.S. 24 on Friday, April 26.

The stoppages are necessary as crews are working at the U.S. 24/150 and Illinois 116 interchange, just east of McClugage Bridge. Work will begin after 8:30 a.m. and there will be stoppages of up to 20 minutes at a time throughout the day.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
