IL 160 from North of US 50 to the Madison County Line in Clinton County

Trenton – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that IL 160 from north of US 50 to the Madison County Line will be intermittently restricted to one lane beginning Tuesday, September 3, 2019, weather permitting. This work will take place daily between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Traffic in each direction will be maintained using flaggers. This work is necessary to complete pavement repairs and asphalt resurfacing and is expected to be completed by late October 2019.

Motorists should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

The contractor on this project is Christ Brothers Asphalt, Inc. of Lebanon, Illinois.
