Lane Restrictions – IL 158/US 50 in St. Clair County

Shiloh – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that the northbound and southbound lanes of IL 158/US 50 from south of US 50 to IL 161 will be restricted beginning Tuesday, September 3, 2019 weather permitting.

All lanes will remain open as followed:

- From US 50 to the Metro Link Station:
Northbound and Southbound lanes between 5:00 AM to 9:00 AM, and 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
- From the Metro Link Station to IL 161
Northbound 5:00 AM to 9:00 AM. and Southbound from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM

Flaggers will be utilized to move traffic through the workzone. These restrictions are needed to resurface the roadway, work should be completed by the end of September.

Motorists should expect delays and allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
