Weekend lane closures on Skokie Highway

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that an ongoing resurfacing project will require lane closures this weekend, weather permitting, on Skokie Highway (U.S. 41) in Highland Park.

The right lanes of both northbound and southbound Skokie Highway will be closed between Chantilly Boulevard (north of Clavey Road) and Lake-Cook Road, in Highland Park, starting at 8 p.m. Friday, August 16. In addition, the entrance ramp from Clavey Road to northbound Skokie Highway will be closed, as will the entrance and exit ramps on southbound Skokie Highway at Skokie Valley Road. All lanes will reopen by 5 a.m. Monday, August 19, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
