## Harlem Avenue bridge repairs over Cal-Sag Channel

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that repairs to the structural steel and deck on the bridge carrying Harlem Avenue (Illinois 43) over the Cal-Sag Channel, in Palos Heights, will require lane reductions and width restrictions starting, weather permitting, Monday, Aug. 12.

In order to complete the work, Harlem Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction with a width restriction of 11 feet.

The work is expected to be complete by the end of November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
