## **Illinois 117 in Goodfield to close Aug. 26** *Railroad crossing repairs expected to last four days*

**GOODFIELD** — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that Illinois 117 in Goodfield will close at 8 a.m. Monday, Aug. 26.

The closure is necessary for repairs to the Norfolk Southern Railway crossing and is expected to last four days, with the road reopening by 3 p.m. Aug. 29. A detour utilizing U.S. 150 and U.S. 24 will be posted, and only local truck traffic will be allowed through Goodfield during the closure.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
