Work on Illinois 164 begins Aug. 26

Repairs to bridge over Henderson Creek

OQUAWKA — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on Illinois 164 about 3 miles south of Oquawka begins Monday, Aug. 26.

The project involves repairs and deck patching to the bridge that carries Illinois 164 over Henderson Creek. Traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by temporary signals. Work is expected to be complete by June 2020.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
