Lane reductions for U.S. 24/U.S. 150/IL 116 work zone *Eastbound down to one lane beginning Aug. 13*

EAST PEORIA — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that traffic patterns in the U.S. 24/U.S. 150/Illinois 116 work zone will change Tuesday, Aug. 13.

Eastbound traffic will be reduced to one lane while westbound traffic remains one lane.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
