## Lane closures on Dundee, Lee and Shermer roads

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that an advance project for a culvert replacement and intersection reconstruction at Dundee and Lee roads, in Northbrook, will require daytime, temporary lane closures on Dundee, Lee and Shermer roads beginning, weather permitting, Tuesday, Feb. 19.

The closures will last until April, weather permitting, when the larger project begins to replace the culvert and reconstruct the intersection, as well as the south leg of Lee Road. Additionally, a bike path and retaining wall will be built at the southeast corner of the intersection.

Starting in April, weather permitting, Dundee Road will be closed from Waukegan Road (Illinois 43) to Skokie Boulevard. Additional information will be made available to the public regarding the closure and detour prior to the start of construction.

The anticipated completion date is late October.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
