## Lane closures on Grand Avenue in Lindenhurst

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that a resurfacing project and other safety improvements on Grand Avenue (Illinois 132) between Munn Road and Deerpath Drive, in Lindenhurst, will require lane closures beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Mar. 4.

In addition to resurfacing Grand Avenue, the existing lanes will be widened with left-turn lanes and a grass median added as well. Curbs, gutters and sewers will be repaired and upgraded. A sidewalk along the south parkway and a bicycle and pedestrian path on the north parkway will be built. Crossings will be upgraded to current standards to make them accessible to pedestrians with disabilities.

Construction will take place initially with daily, temporary lane closures. Staged construction activity will be implemented later in the spring, with turn lanes and one lane open in each direction. The work is expected to be complete by the end of November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
