Illinois 22 closed at Flint Creek in Lake Barrington

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that culvert repairs, pavement patching and guardrail replacements to Illinois 22 over Flint Creek, in Lake Barrington, will require a full closure starting, weather permitting, July 22.

In order to complete the work, Illinois 22 will be closed between Harbor Drive and Old Barrington Road. A detour will direct traffic to U.S. 14 and Illinois 59 (North Hough Road).

The work is expected to be complete by the end of August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
