Bridge repairs on Ogden Avenue in La Grange

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that repairs to the bridge carrying Ogden Avenue (U.S. 34) over the Indiana Harbor Belt Railroad, in La Grange, will require permanent lane closures and width restrictions starting, weather permitting, Friday, July 26.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Burlington Avenue and Washington Avenue. Access to driveways and side streets in the work zone will be maintained during construction. In addition, lane widths in both directions will be reduced to nine feet.

The project consists of repairs to the bridge joints, substructure and concrete.

The work is expected to be complete by the end of October.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
