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Lane reductions on Governors Highway bridge over Rock Creek

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that repairs and the installation of a bridge deck overlay on the bridge carrying Governors Highway (Illinois 50) over Rock Creek will require lane reductions starting, weather permitting, July 22.

In order to complete the project, traffic will initially be reduced to one lane in each direction utilizing the northbound lanes while the southbound lanes are repaired. Once work on southbound lanes is completed, traffic will be shifted to one lane in each direction utilizing the southbound lanes.

The work is expected to be complete by the end of September.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
