## **Lane Restrictions – I-255 in Monroe County**

**COLUMBIA** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that the northbound and southbound lanes of I-255 from IL Rt 3 to the Jefferson Barracks Bridge in Monroe County will be restricted beginning 12:01 AM on Monday, July 8, 2019, weather permitting. Restrictions in the southbound lanes will be between 7:00 PM and 5:00 AM, and between 9:00 PM and 6:00 AM in the northbound lanes. One lane will remain open at all times in each direction. These restrictions are needed to make pavement repairs and work should be completed by early August of this year.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
