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Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that construction work on the structure carrying IL 40 over a tributary to Rock Creek, located 0.3 miles east of Stransky Road, east of Chadwick, started on July 22, 2019. Martin & Co. Excavating will be completing the \$316,458 project involving removal and replacement of a single box culvert and shoulder improvements.

A road closure and detour has been installed for the duration of the work. Thru traffic will be detoured from IL 40 in Milledgeville onto Shannon Route Road to US 52 and into Mt. Carroll. Drivers should adjust travel times for the detour. The road closure and detour will be in place for 15 consecutive calendar days. Work is expected to be completed by August 7, 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
